Prerequisite Knowledge, Experience and Skills:

This is an intermediate level course geared towards Simulator Operators and other faculty who will have the responsibility of operating and implementing Ultrasound in their simulation training. A basic understanding of PC skills and baseline knowledge of your simulator is helpful. Additionally, a fundamental knowledge on the principles of ultrasound acquisition and interpretation would be beneficial.
